

Buffer Zone Baiting Guide

1 Set up your philproof station

1. Thread the spacer onto a nail.
2. Place the bait station about 20cm off the ground - the top should be sitting around knee height.
3. Slide the floor in (with the judder bar facing inwards) and press the front under the tabs.

Do not attach to kauri.

2 Bait

1. Pick up some pre-bagged PESTOFF (Brodifacoum) from Matuku Link, or arrange some through the Buffer Zone Coordinator.
2. Place each bag in the station, wedging the knot under the floor of the station to keep the bag in place.
3. Check and replace at least every three months.

Keep poison away from children and non-target animals.

3 Send information (helpful if you can)

1. Join Predator Free Swanson/Waitākere on Trap.nz.
2. Add your bait stations and estimates of how much bait has been taken (a full bag weighs 150g).

Alternatively, let the Buffer Zone Coordinator know how busy your stations are with an email, text or phone call.

Wear gloves (preferably garden, rubber or nitrile). When handling loose bait, wear a mask.



Wash your hands to remove any bait and protect from diseases, such as leptospirosis.



Wash your clothes to remove any bait residue.



Always **seek medical advice** if poisoning is suspected. Symptoms of poisoning may be delayed.
